(Rules and Regulations)

1. Four (4) Separate events will be held for the game:

CARDET Office 27/10/2014

European University (closed)

University of Nicosia

Cyprus Youth Organization 29/10/2014

2. The Game Language will be in English and Greek

3. Registration is REQUIRED before the tournament to be allowed to participate in the PRIZE: You can apply individually or apply make yourself or team of 4 people. We have all the information on the web.

4. One person from each winning team will get to visit Valencia, Spain to attend the Spanish Development Festival organized with local youth who have participated in the project with 3 more students and the project coordinator in the 30th November.

5. An introductory round of 10 minute test be conducted in order to familiarize the participants on the rules of the game.

6. This is a cooperative game where each team will try to achieve the objectives of the MDGs. It is therefore necessary that participants come in a non-competitive spirit to have a fun time, meet people while playing fairly. Lack of comradeship and cheat or disrespect of the other team is against the mindset of the tournament and we will discourage them with penalty points and expulsion of the tournament.

7. Three (3) games will be played, the score of each of them added and averaged. The team with the highest score with 3 games, is the winner of that tournament.

8. Each game will last 50 minutes. Once that time is reached. The team that manages to finish all regions and get the 8 Millennium Development Goals, will be awarded 100 bonus points.

9. In each game, there will be someone who will control the process called the Secretariat General. This person will be from CARDET and will be knowledgeable of the game.

10. The team that finishes with the largest score wins. Alternatively, the team which gets the highest points (100) as early as possible will win. In the event of a draw the winners will compete in a final game.

11. Playoffs in tournaments. In case of equality of points, the two teams will play one more game. In the event of a continuing tie, both teams will advance to the finals.

12. Tiebreaker in the final. In case of a tie in the final, the tied teams will play as many games as necessary to find a tiebreaker.

13. The dates for the trip are 30th of November to 2nd of December. It will provide free transportation to Valencia (Air Tickets + Bus Tickets), living expenses and Accommodation in Youth Homes. For minors below 18 years of age, we will require the permission of their guardians. The trip will be accompanied by the project coordinator.

14. The rules are subject to change depending on the registered teams or any other reason by the organization, on justification.
